Instructions: Each presentation requires an abstract. Abstracts should be titled and labeled with all authors and their association. Please prepare a 200-300 word abstract of your presentation and save the document with the following format:

On the same document as your abstract give us a short bio of the presenter (less than 100 words) in order for us to announce who is giving the presentation. On the morning of the conference (August 2) bring your PowerPoint presentation on a USB flash drive and give them to the moderator of your session. Presentations will be limited to 30 minutes each.
