7:00-8:00 am: Foresters and organizers arrive at site to prepare seedlings, planting materials, tools for volunteers, etc.

9:00-9:30 am: Volunteers arrive at site

9:30-10:00 am:

- Welcome to everyone, brief orientation, and acknowledgement of participating groups/agencies/partners
- Remarks from representatives from the Green Forests Work
- **All volunteers are trained [1st time] how to plant by forester in large group**
- Volunteers are provided seedlings, planting materials, tools, etc
- Volunteers are broken up into small planting crews and assigned a crew leader (forester or other field professional)
- Crew leaders take their planting crews to designated planting location
- **Volunteers are trained [2nd time] how to plant by crew leader all together in small crew**

10:00 am-3:00 pm: Volunteers plant trees under supervision of crew leader with breaks for water, snacks, and lunch as needed. **Crew leader provides one-on-one training [3rd time] how to plant as volunteers work.**

3:00-3:30 pm: Volunteers depart

Note: All planting tools/equipment will be provided. Each volunteer will need to bring their own lunch, work gloves, be dressed with lots of warm work clothes, wear heavy foot wear, and bring wet weather gear as necessary. Drinking water will be provided. The event will occur regardless of weather conditions (rain, snow or sunshine).
